### Objective:

The objective of this workshop is to bring together experts in concrete pavement mechanics, concrete pavement modeling, and design to discuss the main directions for improvement of future concrete pavement design procedures.

### Workshop Background:

This workshop will model the very successful series of the CROW workshops, which were traditionally held a few days before the European Symposiums on Concrete Roads. This workshop will be the second in a series of fundamental workshops sponsored by ISCP as the first was held in Copper Mountain, Colorado, USA prior to the 8th International Conference on Concrete Pavements in 2005.

The workshop theme will be “Advanced Characterization, Modeling, and Design of Concrete Pavements”. All persons with interest are welcome to participate.

### Workshop Format:

- Every participant will have to submit in advance a short abstract and/or a paper in pdf or MS-Word format to be distributed at the workshop. All new papers will be peer reviewed and, if accepted, published in the International Journal of Pavement Engineering.
- Each participant will make a short presentation followed by round table discussions.
- There will be two brainstorming sessions dealing with the field data interpretation and concrete pavement modeling.
- Recommendations to the 9th International Conference on Concrete Pavements will be discussed and voted on.
