As with the previous international conferences, the focus of the eleventh conference will be to present information on new technologies related to the design, construction and rehabilitation of various types of concrete pavements. This conference is targeted for pavement, materials and geotechnical engineering professionals who are involved in any aspect of concrete pavement design, construction, testing, evaluation and rehabilitation, including:

## PAPER SUBMISSIONS & PEER REVIEW

All potential authors are invited to submit a letter of intent or abstract using the attached Call for Papers response form. All manuscripts submitted for review and publication, and all related poster boards and presentations, must be original—not previously published—and must not be of a commercial nature. ★ Each submission will be peer-reviewed by members of the Technical Paper/Program Review Subcommittee of the Conference Steering Committee. Final decisions concerning presentation and publication will be made based on the results of the review. ★ The schedule for submittal of letters of intent, original manuscripts and revised, “camera-ready” copy is provided in the “Due Dates” section. Please note that the primary author will be required to pre-register for the Conference before the paper will be included in the proceedings and the final program.

## CONFERENCE TOPICS

Papers and conference presentations are being solicited for a wide range of topics related to the mission of the ISCP: to further engineering and technical education, scientific investigation, and research in all areas related to concrete pavements. Papers and presentations dealing with emerging topics are also encouraged. Specific areas of interest include, but are not limited to:

- ★ Design of concrete pavements
- ★ Concrete pavement materials
- ★ Concrete pavement construction
- ★ Preservation of concrete pavements
- ★ Concrete resurfacing solutions/concrete overlays
- ★ Rehabilitation of concrete pavements
- ★ Pavement performance prediction and evaluation
- ★ Durability of concrete pavements
- ★ Techniques for analysis
- ★ Pavement economics and life cycle cost analysis
- ★ Concrete pavement sustainability and life cycle assessment
- ★ Innovative design methods
- ★ Testing, instrumentation and sensing in concrete pavements
- ★ Pavement surface characteristics
- ★ Concrete pavement performance and asset management

Selection of papers will be based on peer reviews of the suitability of the topic, quality of the paper, and near-term applicability of the subject to practice. The conference is expected to be of significant benefit to both practicing and research engineers. The presentations will comprise comprehensive and current coverage on concrete pavement technology.
