## ISCP NEWS

### ISCP Annual Membership Meeting Held In Washington, D.C.

The ISCP Annual Membership Business Meeting was held Saturday, January 12, 2013 in Washington, D.C., USA, in conjunction with the 2013 92<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting of the Transportation Research Board (TRB).



Highlights of the meeting included:

- The 2013 budget (approved by the Board in late 2012) was presented by Secretary-Treasurer Neeraj Buch. Final Society financial statements for 2012 were also presented and reviewed. The Society remains in sound financial condition, largely due to the increased base of organizational members, whose numbers are at a record high.
- The 2012 budget was also presented. The final close out for the 10<sup>th</sup> ICCP and the 3<sup>rd</sup> TW will be done by Jan 31 and the 2012 budget will be finalized and presented to the board for approval.
- President Mark Snyder presented final comments and financial information on the 10<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Concrete Pavements (10<sup>th</sup> ICCP), noting that world economic conditions and other factors had led to a decrease in attendance from the 2008 event. However, sponsor and exhibitor support was a record high in 2012, which helped to keep the event to a nearly revenue-neutral position.
- Director Jeff Roesler summarized the 3<sup>rd</sup> Technical Workshop (TW) that preceded the 10<sup>th</sup> ICCP, noting that this event turned a small profit. He asked that this money be set aside toward the planning and conduct of the 4<sup>th</sup> TW in 2016. Roesler also noted that the TW presentations will be posted on the ISCP website.
- Past-President Dan Zollinger is working on developing a slate of candidates for the upcoming fall ISCP Officer Elections, and is also accepting nominations for ISCP Honorary Membership.
- The Australian Society for Concrete Pavements is organizing a technical workshop in 2013 and ISCP has been invited to participate. There is also a possibility to hold an ISCP-sponsored workshop in Peru.
- Corey Zollinger (CEMEX) presented a proposal from Texas-based industry members for holding the 11<sup>th</sup> ICCP in San Antonio in 2016.
- There was extensive discussion of the benefits of ISCP membership (what they currently are and what additional benefits would be useful) as well as discussion of membership recruitment and retention efforts.

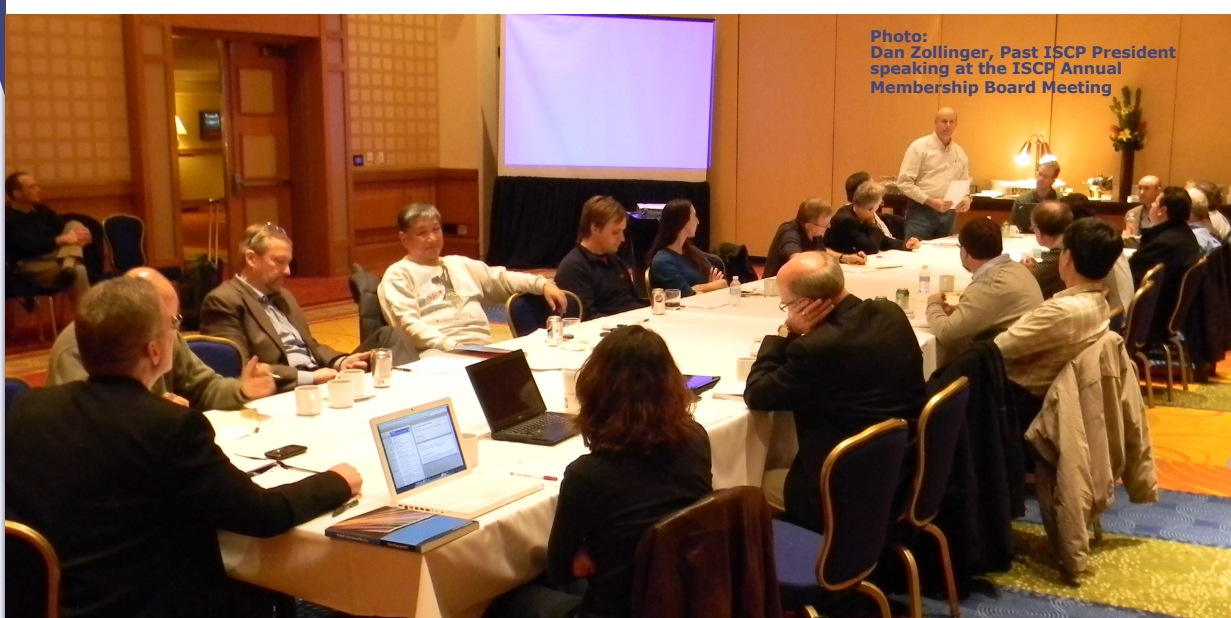

- Other related topics

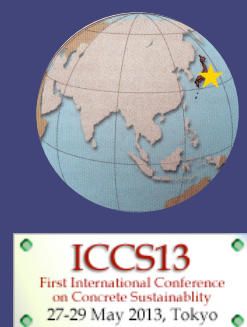
