Peter Deem to Receive 2012 NRMCA Lifetime Achievement Award



The 2012 NRMCA Lifetime Achievement Award for Promotion will be awarded to ISCP Member, Peter Deem, who recently retired from Holcim where he began as a market manager in June 1982. The Award recognizes excellence in concrete promotion on behalf of the entire industry over the full career of the award winner.

Early in his career, Peter performed a variety of jobs for Holcim, which led to his position as Vice-President of Sales for the West during the 1990s. EUPAVE Releases New Brochure: "Concrete Pavements Contribute to Decarbonizing of Transport"

Combatting climate change is a major environmental concern for the European Union. Surface transport represents 28% of total CO_2 emissions, 75% of which are generated by road transport. Consequently, developing a more sustainable transport network is a priority.



EUPAVE's new brochure aims at disseminating the benefits of concrete against global warming, focusing on the fact that trucks consume less fuel on rigid pavements compared to flexible pavements. Supported by international studies and research, this statement is documented

and the results are shown in this brochure. In the future, the goal is to use this brochure as a key variable in the decision-making processes for sustainable infrastructure and to be part of all future evaluation procedures for green public procurement.

The brochure will officially be presented to MEP Mr. Philippe De Backer, Member of European Parliament's Committee on Transport and Tourism, during a press event on March 21, 2012.

"Life-Cycle Cost Analysis" (EB011/PDF) is a 128-page publication which begins by discussing LCCA in general terms and then providing detailed steps for conducting a single-project LCCA. Examples with detailed analyses are provided for LCCAs of a local road, highway, and airport pavement. The document also covers some applications and extensions of LCCA, such as the

- "mix of fixes" concept
- sustainability in the context of LCCA
- total ownership cost • role of LCCA in pavement type selection
- impact of material quantity specifications on LCCA results

The appendices include a deterministic LCCA worksheet, a discussion of historical oil price trends and volatility, and all current federal policies on pavement type selection.

"Best Practices for Airport Concrete Pavement Construction" (EB102/PDF) is a 180-page publication which details best practices from design and pre-construction considerations through the final steps of airport concrete pavement construction, and even early-age distress repair. The appendices include checklists for pre-construction considerations, inspection and testing, and joint sawing. A decision tree for early-age cracking is also included in the appendices.

HeidelbergCement Tests Innovative Concrete HEIDELBERGCEMENT **Construction Methods on the A94 Motorway**

In order to locate the optimum road surface, the Federal Ministry of Transport, Building and Urban Development (BMVBS) and the German Federal Highway Research Institute (BASt) have been testing new road surfaces for many years in Germany. HeidelbergCement AG also provided stimulation for new construction methods using their own pilot section in Geseke, Germany.

HeidelbergCement has been carrying out intensive tests on new, innovative concrete road surfaces under different load and utilization conditions. Among several tests, the one with the main section containing a continuously reinforced jointless pavement has proven to be the most successful.

A new characteristic is now added to this pavement called "grinding texture". During grinding, longitudinal grooves are ground into the concrete surface using a shaft equipped with diamond grinding wheels. Siegfried Riffel, Project Manager for Infrastructure in the Development and Applications Department at HeidelbergCement, explains:

"This grinding texture provides several advantages:

- it can be carried out independent of the weather conditions
- it produces an absolutely smooth, extremely low-noise good-grip road surface
- any irregularities from the surface production process are ground out.

This procedure proved to be most impressive on the test section in Geseke, with a reduction in noise of up to four decibels in comparison to the reference noise level.

EUPAVE acknowledges Heidelberg Cement for the authorization to publish the study as well as the innovative work on the A94.
