Netherlands to USA: Solar Panels Far Exceed Expectations & Pave Way for Power-Producing Pavements

A 3-year pilot project/experimental bike path with solar panels has generated more than 3,000 kilowatt-hours during its first six months of operation in Amsterdam, Netherlands—far exceeding engineers' expectations. The project could pave the way for solar-roadway

technologies being used to power street lights, traffic systems, and electric cars. "SolaRoad"—first-of-its-kind path—opened in November 2014 in Krommenie, a village northwest of the Dutch city of Amsterdam, Netherlands. So far, it has generated enough energy to power a one-person household for an entire year [Associated Press reported] ...

"We did not expect a yield as high as this so quickly," Sten de Wit, Engineer/Senior Advisor-Netherlands Organization for Applied Scientific Research, Helmond, Netherlands (TNO-Netherlands), which is part of the consortium that created the 70-meter-long path—a "golden triangle" of industry, research institutions, and government—that is collectively creating innovation ...

Electricity generated by the panels is fed into the electricity grid ...

In the United States, a similar initiative to build solar energy-generating roads is underway ...

Sri. Nitin Gadkari Transport Minister of India

Why India Project is Investing in 100% Concrete Roads

Sri. Nitin Gadkari, *Transport Minister of India* said, "100% of roads in a \$4.7 billion development project will be cement/concrete. This large-scale infrastructure program involves converting 12 major ports into smart cities." This is a significant investment in surface transportation infrastructure, and even more so when considering the economies of the United States and India:

Gross Domestic Product (GDP): USA: \$17 trillion **India:** \$2 billion Gross National Income (GNI) per capita: USA: \$53,750 **India:** \$5,350

Sri. Gadkari said the public-private partnership model is a compulsion, so that government resources can be focused on the rural and agriculture sectors. "You won't hear any complaints that roads are not being constructed or are lying vacant."

In the article from the web portal Rediff India Abroad (Indian news, information, entertainment and shopping), 23 questions were asked of Sri. Gadkari. Two questions were: "Will all roads be built with cement/concrete?"

Mr. Gadkari answered, "Yes, 100 per cent! Cement roads have a life of 100 years and bitumen roads have a life of five years ...

"What is the delivered cost of cement/concrete?"

He replied, "Ministry of Road Transport and Highways-Government of India have a website called NAM-Pro—the Platform for Infrastructure and Materials Providers. INAM-Pro has brought down costs for cement procurement." He added ...

A YouTube video featuring Sri. Nitin Gadkari, explained that they are also planning for the "Chaar Dhaam Yatra" highway project. It is the highway-connection of the four holy towns ...




