August 30 through September 3, 2020 in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA. The 12th ICCP theme is:

• Making Waves with Durable, Resilient Concrete Pavements

This conference is held every 4 years and will carry on the tradition of a series of international conferences begun in 1977 by Purdue University—organized by ISCP since the 7th ICCP in 2001 in Orlando, Florida. As with the previous international conferences, the focus of the twelfth conference will be to present information on new technologies related to the design, construction and rehabilitation of various types of concrete pavements.

The 12th ICCP is targeted for pavement, materials, and geotechnical engineering professionals who are involved in any aspect of concrete pavement design, construction, testing, evaluation, and rehabilitation including the following:
