ABOUT THIS FORUM

A definition of "sustainability" is the ability to maintain rates of renewable resource harvest, pollution creation, and non-renewable resource depletion that can be continued indefinitely.

Patrick Hastings will outline ISCA's role in infrastructure sustainability, and its tools and resources.

James Fleetwood will highlight the common defects found on the Woolgoolga to Ballina rigid pavements Sections 3 & 4. He will discuss the causes and the pre-approved dispositions established for their swift rectification for a defect-free handover.

Basil Ben will provide an update regarding revisions to specifications and drawings, and the rigid pavement technology program.

Increasing demands and expectations of road authorities and users, and reduced working windows, are creating pressure on contractors to deliver cost effective and innovative solutions for concrete road maintenance. **Paul Burville** will explore different options.

There has been relatively little use of dowels in NSW road pavements since the 1970s, but they are receiving renewed interest with the increase in urban widening of old dowelled JRPC pavements. **Geoff Ayton** and **Sid Daher** will provide a review of the key requirements for the successful design and installation of dowels.

Justin Moss will provide an insight into the exciting future of ASCP, including the strategy for 2020, Corporate Membership improvements, more stakeholder engagement, and increased use of social media. **Kevin Abrams** will provide an overview of the upcoming events in 2020 and the next conference in 2021.
