## Officer and Committee Reports

President's Report (Hiller)

- 2021 highlights 12th ICCP, <u>ISCP Q&O page</u>, membership changes planning, new honorary members inducted
  - o 700 attendees at the 12<sup>th</sup> ICCP, 31 countries represented
  - o Thanks to the conference sponsors: ACPA, Cemex, Lehigh-Hanson and workshop sponsors (10).
  - o 5 honorary members inducted. Catching up from previous nominations and delay in ICCP.
  - o Three paper awards representing several countries.
  - o Overall international presence strong in presentations and awards
  - o Thanks to all supporting members including the 12th ICCP planning committee
  - o Q&O page: started year ago
    - Ask ISCP members for opinions/experiences
- 2022 plans and challenges— 13<sup>th</sup> ICCP committee kickoff, new webinar series with IRF, website updates, DOIs for ICCP papers, classic paper repository, and implementing membership drive
  - Already planning 13<sup>th</sup> ICCP
    - Please let Hiller know if you want to assist with the planning committee.
  - o IRF webinar series
    - Need to restart
    - Focus on elementary pavement topics
  - Loose Ends
    - 14 plagues ordered
    - Need to finalize contract with SB2, awaiting final processing of videos and fulfillment of contract obligations.
    - One workshop sponsor has not paid
    - 20% proceedings have DOIs and awaiting authors approval for about 50%

- Some papers have outstanding revisions that are being worked on
- o Membership changes, move to calendar year approach
- Want to publish old conference papers
  - o Similarly, want to compile a classic paper repository for members

## Secretary-Treasurer and Vice-President's Reports (Amirkhanian and C. Zollinger)

- 2021 financial summary and 2022 proposed budget
  - o 12<sup>th</sup> ICCP brough in approximately \$50k
  - We are ending 2021 with approximately \$60k in the bank. This amount does not include several pending deposits and completion of the conference hosting contract.
  - Expected to end with approximately \$64k at the conclusion of 2022, assuming all pending deposits clear and completion of the conference hosting contract from the 12<sup>th</sup> ICCP.
- Online banking switch plans
  - O Have already started process to switch to a new bank that can handle more tasks in a remote fashion

## Director of Communication (Sen and Salles)

- Website redesign
  - o Too many plugins, have already started reduce them
  - o Proposing new theme that is not customized
    - Should significantly reduce time spent on fixing errors
    - Allow flexibility to incorporate new features and keep site updated without constantly breaking dependencies
- Newsletter changes
  - o Proposing to reduce emails that newsletter is sent to and removing duplicates.
    - Currently counts against free limit
    - Have already been charged for higher tier from the plugin
  - Based on student pitch in 12<sup>th</sup> ICCP, introduced student research spotlight in the monthly newsletter
    - Already underway

### Standing Committee Reports

- Nominating Committee (Roesler) Election in early 2022 for EC positions
  - o Nominations: President-Jake Hiller, Tom Burnham-VP, Armen Amirkhanian-Sec/Treasurer
  - o Election completed by end of January
  - o Two open board positions
- International Conference Committee (Hiller) Kick-off in early 2022
  - O Not a lot of time before it starts
  - o Let Hiller know if interested in serving on committee
- Membership Committee (Hiller) Looking for members
  - Automated emails regarding membership do not convey the same active membership we want in the society
    - Need 4 to 6 board members to serve on committee

- Ferrebee (BoD), Snyder, and C. Zollinger volunteered to help membership committee
- High priority
- o Gudimettla how many members?
  - Amirkhanian, about 55-60 paid members
- Jain Send email to IITs to get members, Indians Road Congress
- Snyder where does newsletter go? Just members?
  - Hiller: broad distribution
- O D. Zollinger how many authors were members?
  - Amirkhanian about 80% of manuscripts had an author who were some type of member, not common to have non-members as all authors on a manuscript
  - D. Zollinger we used to have more active members
- o C. Zollinger sometimes payment gets overlooked
  - Gudimettla I don't know when I need to pay
- o Hiller we have a \$2k budget item for someone to monitor it
- o Ceylan option credit card for recurring payment
  - Hiller- check in on that
- O C. Zollinger breaking even on dues, we put on conference/newsletter, if we want to change, we need to be active
- o D. Zollinger What is role of ISCP? Need to identify this
- Speakmon No newsletter or other contact
- O D. Zollinger Who can manage this?
  - Hiller need to identify someone, 2022 budget has money set aside for an administrative position
- o Snyder who is chairing member committee?
  - Hiller Nassiri/Covarrubias are the current chairs, but Nassiri has rotated off the board
  - Bylaws say board members must serve on standing committees
- o Ferrebee, C. Zollinger, and Snyder will help on the committee
- Wathne IRF has a large audience, no cost to ISCP
- o Snyder Newsletter maybe twice a month but half content
- Moss I suggest WEEKLY with even less content, (there's nothing more frustrating than a monthly newsletter with 30 GREAT articles)
- o D. Zollinger newsletter should promote membership
  - G. Dean Just not sure how a more frequent newsletter will drive more membership? Not connecting the dots. Two sep issues.
  - Hiller I think the more frequent newsletters may be to increase visibility, but also to maintain a more digestible level of content when it does comes out.
  - Moss The thing about Newsletters is to see them as a 'service' to members - that service being CURATION of relevant articles for their potential convenience.
- Ceylan Not a good idea to tie membership to newsletter/IRF
- Wathne membership revenue should cover yearly operating expenses
